# **GENERAL SUPPLY LIST**

2023-2024

The general supply list applies to all Prep students. While not comprehensive, this list does include most supplies necessary for the year. Students will be given directions from teachers regarding supplies specific to their individual classes if applicable. This list is in addition to the grade level supply list that includes items specific to your student's grade level. All items should be free from pop culture references, but otherwise can be any color or design. We encourage you to label everything with names.

Locker assignments will be distributed when students get their class schedules at the **Meet the Teacher** event in early August. The interior of the lockers measures 14 3/4 across by 16 1/2 inches deep. These measurements can be used if purchasing locker shelving or roller backpacks to determine what will fit inside.

PLEASE LABEL ITEMS WITH STUDENT NAMES. It increases the likelihood of a lost item being reunited with it's owner.

### As needed throughout the school year:

- Numeric or Letter lock for locker (no key locks)
- Black or blue pens
- #2 Pencils
- Dry erase markers
- Highlighters
- Lined paper (7<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> should purchase College Ruled)
- 3x5 note cards (about 300; should be kept at home)
- Manuscript paper (example <u>here</u>)
- Hard pencil case for art supplies

# **GRADE SPECIFIC SUPPLY LIST**

# 2023-2024

The grade specific supply list includes items your student will need based on their grade level. This is in addition to the general supplies. **Prep does not offer a consumable bundle like many of the Archway schools**. If your student already has their recorder or any other applicable supplies from previous years, there is no need to purchase the items again; they can be used again if they are in good condition. The recorder will be used through their middle school years.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Three 1.5" or 2" binders with tabs and dividers, enough for seven classes
- One sketchbook, 100 sheets, 9"x12" or larger
- Color pencils, 12 ore more
- Graphite sketching pencils (ex. 8B-6H range of pencils)
- One bevel eraser, one kneader eraser, one hand-held pencil sharpener
- One pair of safety scissors
- Four notebooks <u>or</u> Composition notebooks
- Manuscript paper (blank staff paper)
- One plastic container for art supplies

### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Scientific Calculator, 2-line display, TI-30 or similar
  - May not be a graphing calculator
- Three-ring binder with tabs and adequate lined paper
  - o Family may choose how many and in what size, depending on how the student wants to organize
  - Suggestions include 1) two three-inch binders for three classes each, 2) three two-inch binders for two classes each, or 3) six one-inch binders each for one class
  - Separate binder for Latin
- Folders with pockets and prongs for math
- Graphing notebook
- Soprano Recorder YRS-24B (example here), in neutral/beige color
- Composition notebook college ruled
  - Lit Comp and Science will require a dedicated notebook for each class
- Sketchbook (at least 9"x12")
- Compressed charcoal sticks (Generals brand recommended)
- Charcoal pencils (General brand recommended & 2B,4B,6B; avoid Artist Loft, Royal & Langnickle, Amazon Basics)
- One white rubber eraser
- One kneaded eraser
- Handheld pencils sharpener with a shaving catch
- Chamois dry rag type, not the premoistened type sold in plastic tubes
- Chalk pastels (Mungyo Gallery Artist brand recommended, 24 minimum)
- Graphite sketching pencils 4H-4B
- One plastic container for art supplies
- Small sanding pad
- Wash Cloths (any old rag will do)
- Tortillons/ blending stumps
- Felt
- Small pair of scissors

#### 8th Grade
