

How To Read Your Schedule

- **Period** – There is a lot of information in this section, but the only thing you need to really pay attention to is the number just before the parentheses (**MH1(R_B-HDG)**). MH1 is a 1st period class for all students, **MH2** is a second period class for all students. This follows the day through 6th period with the exception of 4th period. **8H4** is a 4th period class for 8th graders and all high school students, while **674** is a 4th period class for all 6th and 7th graders. The schedule lists classes chronologically starting with 1st period, ending with 6th.
 - **For 6th Grade Families** – your students will have what is called a Gold/Blue schedule where they alternate Latin and PE classes every school day. For these classes, you can see that the letters in the parentheses will have a **B** (for blue days) or a **G** (for gold days). Use the [Gold/Blue schedule](#) for exact days. Your teachers actively communicate and remind students throughout the year what day it is! Please talk to them if you have questions on this schedule.
- **Term** – S1 is a first semester class (starting in August), S2 is a second semester class (starting in January), and 23-24 means the class takes place all year. In this example, the student will have Music Theory in the first semester, and Studio Art the second semester.
- **Course** – This is the class you are scheduled for during that period.
- **Teacher** – This is the teacher for the classes your student is taking. To get a hold of them, follow [this link to our contact page](#).
- **Room** – This is the room the class will take place in. 300-level classes are downstairs, while 400-level classes are upstairs. PE and Drama will take place in the Gymnasium building.
