

GENERAL SUPPLY LIST 2024-2025

The general supply list applies to all Prep students. This list is in addition to the grade level supply list that includes items specific to your student's grade level. All items should be free from pop culture references, but otherwise can be any color or design. **We encourage you to label everything with names.** There are Amazon links for the general and grade-specific supply lists for you to use if you'd like but you are welcome to purchase supplies anywhere that suits you.

Locker assignments will be distributed when students get their class schedules at the **Meet the Teacher** event on July 30. The interior of the lockers measures 14 3/4 across by 16 1/2 inches deep. These measurements can be used if purchasing locker shelving or roller backpacks to determine what will fit inside.

[As needed throughout the school year](#)

- Three ring binder with tabs. 6th graders should have one for each class (seven in total) with five-tab dividers in each, while 7th-11th graders can determine how they want to organize their binders. Suggestions include: 1) two three-inch binders for three classes each, 2) three two-inch binders for two classes each, or 3) six one-inch binders each for one class.
- Numeric or Letter lock for locker (no key locks)
- Black or blue pens
- #2 Pencils
- Dry erase markers
- Graphing notebook and/or loose-leaf graphing paper (7th – 11th, Math)
- Highlighters
- Lined paper (7th – 12th should purchase College Ruled)
- 3x5 note cards (about 300; should be kept at home)
- Manuscript paper
- Hard pencil case for art supplies
- Recorder (*for Middle School if you do not already have one*)
