

8TH Grade End of Year Party Information and Waiver

By purchasing your ticket, you agree to adhere to the guidelines and rules set forth here. Failure to do so can result in you being asked to leave the event immediately and potential discipline following.

Only current 8th grade LPA students are permitted to attend the Lincoln Prep 8th Grade End of Year Party on May 9th. No guests from other grades or schools are allowed. This is a student only event, no parents or siblings.

The end of year party is located at the Crown Plaza San Marcos Hotel in the San Tan Ballroom. 1 San Marcos Place, Chandler, AZ 85225

Tickets are \$20 a piece through May 8th on the Payment Portal and will then go up to \$25 the day of at the door.

*Doors will open at 7pm. Students may begin arriving as early as 6:50pm but will not be permitted inside until 7pm. The event will end at 9:00pm at which time students will need to be picked up. **There are no in and out privileges. If you leave the event, you will not be allowed back inside.***

Drop off instructions – *students should enter through the pathway off the parking lot on the North side of the hotel and NOT enter through the hotel lobby. The pathway is located right next to building that says “San Marcos Ballroom.” Watch for the sign in the parking lot to direct you where to go.*

Behavior expectations - *Students are expected to follow school rules for behavior and to comport themselves appropriately, displaying respect, courtesy, and helpfulness to fellow students and to chaperones. They must follow directions given by chaperones and refrain from public displays of affection. Any violation of Lincoln Prep’s code of behavior may result in a call to parents and the student’s removal from the event.*

Vulgar, obscene, or profane language will not be tolerated. Respectful behavior will be expected:

- *All adults are treated with equal respect- DJ, chaperones, teachers, etc.*
- *All fellow students will be treated with respect: no fighting, roughhousing, or bullying.*
- *All attendees will be respectful of the facility and the grounds.*

Alcohol use or intoxication, tobacco, drug use (legal or illegal), and weapons are prohibited. All behavioral/social guidelines outlined in the handbook will be enforced as applicable. Chaperones/teachers may take actions they judge necessary to enforce these guidelines, up to and including removal of a student from the event. Parents/guardians will be notified if student is denied entry or ejected for violations. Misconduct at a school-sponsored social event can result in disciplinary sanctions at school.

Dress code - *The dress code is “Dressy Casual” This is a special occasion so dress accordingly:*

- *Young men – nice pants, jeans, or short (not athletic and no holes), shirts should be free of holes, socks and shoes (no sandals, flip flops), and no hats indoors.*
- *Young women – modest skirts and dresses no shorter than the uniform skirt, or appropriately fitting nice pants, jeans or shorts (not athletic and no holes), shirts free of holes; bare midriffs are*

not acceptable. Modestly cut sleeveless tops/dresses are allowed, but no strapless, low-cut, no back, or spaghetti-strap tops. No tank tops. Shoes should be safe and appropriate with less than a 3-inch heel (no casual sandals or flip flops).

STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT WITHIN THE DRESS CODE WILL HAVE THEIR PARENT CALLED AND THE PARENT WILL HAVE TO BRING THEM A CHANGE OF CLOTHES.

Cell Phone Policy – Cell phones, if brought to the event, will be collected at the door. They are not allowed in the Ballroom. Students will, at the door, place their cell phones into an envelope with their name on it so they may pick their cell phone up at the end of the night. A phone will be available for use throughout the night should an emergency arise. Students found using their cell phone during the dance will be given a warning and escorted to check in. A second offense will result in the student being asked to leave the dance.

Pick up Instructions – All students must be picked up by 9:10pm. Students can only be released to parents at the event location. **No student will be allowed to walk to another location.**

If you do not register through the Payment Portal, you may purchase your ticket at the door for \$25 (EXACT CASH ONLY) with a signed permission slip.
