Course Descriptions

Course	Description	Schedule	Fee
Math Prep for Prep	This two-week course (first half) is designed to help incoming 6 th grade students learn and review some of the fundamental math skills they will need to be successful in 6 th grade math at Lincoln Prep.	June 2 – June 13 M-Th, 10 am -12 pm	\$250
Math Fundamentals	This four-week course is available to all current 6 th and 7 th grade students who either need to retake the course, could use a review of this course, or are new to the school. The course covers the main concepts from our 6 th and 7 th grade math curriculum. Students who are struggling can use this course to deepen their understanding. Students entering 7 th or 8 th grade can use this course to ensure they are on track and are prepared for the next level of mathematics.	June 2nd – June 26 M-Th, 8am -12 pm	\$425
Latin I/II	This four-week course is available to all students entering 7 th and 8 th grade, especially those new to Great Hearts. This course is recommended for all students transferring to Lincoln after 6th grade. This course reviews fundamental 6 th and 7 th grade Latin skills, including vocabulary and grammar.	June 2nd – June 26 M-Th, 8am -12 pm	\$425
Study Skills & Organization	This two-week course (second half) is available to all middle school students but is especially recommended for all incoming 6 th grade students and those new to Lincoln Prep to get a head start on their middle school career. This course teaches valuable skills to help students balance their academic lives and increase their preparedness and productivity. It will give students focused practice <u>in</u> the habits of reading for information, note taking, homework and classwork completion, seminar participation, and organizational skills.	June 16 th – June 26 M-Th, 10 am – 12 pm	\$250

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Course Guarantee: All course offerings are dependent upon satisfactory student enrollment (at least five students must be registered for the course to occur). Lincoln Prep reserves the right to cancel any course offering due to insufficient enrollment. All enrollees will be refunded in full if the class does not meet its enrollment.

Homework: Homework may be assigned to strengthen student understanding from each class meeting. In order to cover the essential concepts of a year-long course, instructors will clearly communicate student expectations in this area.

Dress Code: Students must wear their school uniforms to summer school. Summer school is open to all Great Hearts students. Students are required to conform to Lincoln Preparatory Academy standards of behavior and dress code, outlined in the Family Handbook posted on the school's website. Students who attend from other Great Hearts schools may wear the uniform of their school.

Lockers and Snacks: Students will not have access to lockers during summer school. Students may bring a snack to eat during break time but it should be kept in their bag until that time. Snacks are not provided by the school during the summer; please be sure to send snacks with your child if they need them during the day.

Pickup & Drop-Off: Students may be dropped off at school at the east entrance (facing Gilbert Rd.) as early as 7:45 a.m. Students must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after their course ends. If a family needs a student to leave class early, a parent/guardian should notify the Lincoln Prep Summer School Director at least 24 hours ahead. Students will not be released from class without parental notification.

If your student has a sibling taking a summer school course at Archway Lincoln, your student may be picked up on the Archway side, but Prep students are not allowed to grab their Archway sibling themselves. They will wait outside of Archway for their sibling. Normal Archway dismissal procedures will apply to those younger students.

Students with Allergies and/or Medications: Please note that you must provide the Summer School Director with any medication (clearly labeled with name and instructions) prior to your child attending the first day of their summer school class. Students will not have access to the front office or health assistant.

Behavior: Students are expected to behave in a manner consistent with the behavioral expectations of Lincoln as outlined in the Lincoln Prep Family Handbook posted on the school's website. Students removed from a class or activity for disciplinary reasons will jeopardize their continued enrollment in the program as well as their registration fee(s).
