General Supplies for Locker and Lunch:

- [Numeric or Letter Combination Lock for locker \(no key locks\)](#)
- Locker organizer—this is **optional** but helpful, especially for 6th graders. Any organizer or shelf that fits the dimensions below will work! Lockers will be assigned at Meet the Teacher in July. **For reference, the interior of the school lockers measures 14 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches wide by 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches deep by 32.5 inches high (from bottom of locker hooks to floor of locker).**
- Backpack (no pop culture)
- Lunchbox (no pop culture)
- **Spill-proof/leak-proof** water bottle (flip straws only)

Supplies Needed in EVERY class:

For Lit/Comp
